Downtown A-Frame Sign Guidance:

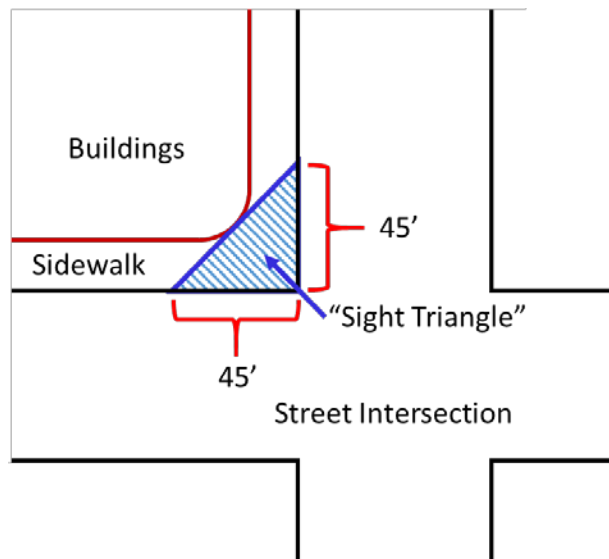
Described below are general guidelines about using and placing A-Frame signs in the Downtown area.

General:

- Signs will be put-out and taken-in daily (signs should not be left out after business hours)
- Signs will be constructed with materials and in a manner that provides a stable base that is wind resistant.
- Signs inside the “sight triangle” will be no taller than 30 inches.
- Signs outside the “sight triangle” will be no taller than 36 inches nor wider than 24 inches.
- Signs will be kept in a clean and safe condition.
- Signs will be positioned using common sense and in consideration for neighboring business owners.

Safety:

- Sign owners assume all liability.
- Signs will not be placed in a location that blocks or restricts access to the wheel chair ramps or substantially restricts pedestrian movement on a sidewalk.
- Signs placed at a street corner must not obstruct the line of sight drivers need to safely traverse the intersection. Within the “sight triangle” signs can be no taller than 30 inches. See the diagram.



NOTE: A-Frame sign guidance is published by the Main Street Board and serves as “recommended” guidelines until the City Commission considers changes to the existing sign Ordinance.
