Cottage Food Producers

Are “home based” vendors selling food products cooked and prepared in their kitchen and meet special requirements established by the Texas Department of Health.

- Is an individual operating out their home.
- Is exempt from normal food establishment requirements and inspections.
- Requires no special permit.
- Produces a variety of “home baked or produced” foods.
- Annual income less than \$50,000.
- Sells directly to individuals at home or Farmers Market.
- May not sell foods requiring refrigeration.
- Must complete basic food safety training.
- Food must be properly labeled.

- Unroasted nut butters
- Fruit butters
- Jams and Jellies
- Fruit Pies
- Dehydrated Fruit or Vegetables
- Dried beans
- Popcorn
- Popcorn snacks
- Cereal
- Granola
- Dry trail mix
- Vinegar
- Pickles
- Mustard
- Roasted Coffee
- Dried tea
- Dried herb mixes
- Syrups





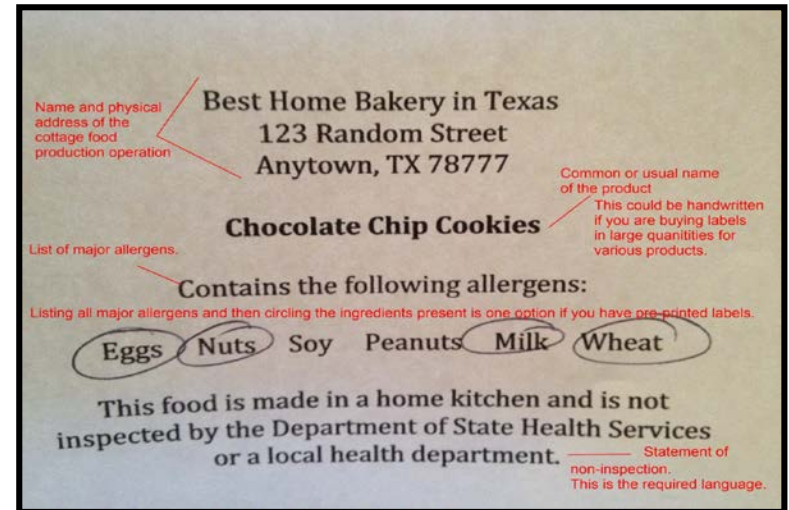
Cottage Food Products (NOT-Allowed)

- Meat or meat products
- Canned fruits, vegetables, vegetable butters and salsa
- Kolaches with meat
- Fish or shellfish products
- Canned pickled products, corn relish and sauerkraut
- Raw seed sprouts
- Baked Goods that require refrigeration.
- Cream custard cream cheese icings
- Milk or cheeses, hard or soft
- Cottage cheeses and yogurts
- Fresh fruits dipped or coated in confections
- Juices made from fresh fruits and vegetables
- Ice or ice products
- Barbeque sauces or ketchup
- Dried pasta
- Sauerkraut, relishes, salsas and sorghum
- Lemonade, juices, hot chocolate
